Dear Colleagues and Friends,

In order to foster research in international trade and foreign direct investment (FDI) in China, we establish the **China Trade and Investment Workshop (CTIW)**. CTIW differs itself from other existing associations, conferences, and workshops in a number of ways. First, it is a specialized workshop focusing on international trade and FDI. Second, it is in small scale in order to facilitate exchange of ideas and research collaborations in China. Third, it is a seminar type of workshop in order to allow more discussions on each paper. Each speaker has 1 hour and 30 minutes. Fourth, it includes a stable group of researchers. We expect that people in this group can attend most of the workshops so that they not only benefit from other people's comments, but also contribute to CTIW by providing comments on other people's work. Finally, it is a bilingual workshop with both English and Chinese.

CTIW will be held at least once a year, hosted by various universities on rotation. The first year's workshop will be hosted by Guanghua School of Management, Peking University, on October 10 and 11. MA Jie is the local organizer. The format of the workshop can be found on the attached tentative workshop program. Your submission will be considered by a scientific committee. Acceptance of presentation will be announced by September 10. There is no submission fee and registration fee.
